### Claiming Credit:

- Use the drop down list to identify the ACR activity you are participating in.
  - Once selected, click on "List Sessions by Activity".
  - You can click on the date in which you would like to claim sessions, or scroll through the entire session list.
  - Check the "Add" box for each session you attended.
  - Click "Claim Sessions" at the top or bottom of the screen to save.
  - If you accidentally claimed a session that you did not attend, click "This is not the Session I attended" at the bottom of the Attestation page.
